Who is our course for? >

These English courses for adults are aimed at people from around the world aged 18 years or older who wish to prepare for Cambridge Exams (eg. FCE, CAE).

What are the course options? >

Whatever course you choose, our teachers are going to help you to achieve the goals you have set for your stay in Ireland:

Certificate in Advanced English (Code: CAE-DL) >

CAE Exam English classes provide students with 3 or 6 hours classes each week giving them the opportunity to review their existing language skills; acquire new ones; practise everything they have learnt; and successfully communicate in English.

- Monday and/or Wednesday 18:45-21:45
- Maximum 8 students per class. Average of 6 students per class

First Certificate in English (Code: FCE-DL) >

Weekend English Course for Adults (Code: WEA-DL) >

On our standard and intensive courses, we offer

- average class sizes of 6 students per class
- with maximum class sizes of 8 students per class.
 *Most language schools have maximum class sizes of at least 12 students per class in summer with an average of 10.

*All of our courses, except for private 1-1 classes, will have a minimum class size of 4 students per class. If there are less than 4 students in any class, we will provide a **more intensive** alternative class.
