When is the course available?


The course is available in July and August 2022.

Where is the English study holiday based?

Dun Laoghaire, Dublin

This **summer junior English study holiday** takes place in an area called Dun Laoghaire (pronounced like *'dunliri'*) which is part of Dublin, the capital of Ireland. It is a beautiful seaside town and well-known as a very safe and upmarket part of Dublin. The town centre is small and very safe and easy for young students to find their way around. It has lots of amenities with shopping centres, cinema, cafes, library etc

- The English course takes place in a purpose-built national school in Dun Laoghaire (*not at our offices!*)
- The school is a 5-minute walk from the centre of Dun Laoghaire and has all the facilities and recreation amenities of a typical school.
- The area is known as a very safe, picturesque and up-market part of Dublin. It has lots of transport links and is an ideal base from which to explore as Dublin city centre is only 20 minutes away in one direction and the beautiful natural landscapes of Wicklow 20 minutes away in the other direction



• Host families are all located within the Dun Laoghaire area – within 10-30 minutes of the school. Students travel to and from their host families each day on public transport and it is very safe and easy to do so. Host families show students the best and safest way to travel.

About our English Classes

We provide:

- 15 hours of General English classes per week (Monday-Friday 09:15-12:30)

- 6 levels of English classes from Beginners (A1) to Advanced (C2)
- Online assessment test before arrival and personal oral test on first day
- Special focus on getting students 'speaking' and using the language successfully by focusing on topics relevant to the student
- **'Meet your Peers'** new feature !- meet and learn with Irish teenagers for a class each week in the classroom
- Average class sizes of 12 students per class (Maximum 15)
- Use of all course materials and use of modern, interactive, classroom technology

- A short piece of homework most days this can involve getting students to find out information from their host families or some other task designed to exercise their English outside of class

Important: We focus on 'speaking'

At DLTC English Language School, our belief is that you haven't really learned a language until you can speak it. Many students arrive at our school with some ability to answer English grammar questions in books but with little experience in using that knowledge and actually speaking the language. Therefore, while our classes also cover grammar, writing, listening and reading, our main focus is getting students to speak the language successfully. We do this by focusing on relevant, real-world topics that are of interest to the student and that are matched to their level. We have 6 class levels available from Elementary A1 to Advanced C1 so whether a student is only beginning in English or aiming for a Cambridge exam, we know our classes will help them succeed at their goals. Our aim is that at the end of the course each student will be able to talk about their summer in Ireland and depart with better fluency, an increased vocabulary and a greater confidence in their use of English.

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Accommodation with Irish families

Students can choose to stay with a local family. It's a great way to practise speaking English and to gain a real cultural experience by discovering what life is like in an Irish home. Irish host families are very welcoming. They take a great interest in their guests and often include the student in the family activities. Our students often comment how they feel at home and like one of the family! (*Tip:* While not necessary, we do suggest that students, particularly younger students, should have at least a little experience of being away from parents before – it helps relieve worry of parents and students.)

What you can expect:

- A welcoming and caring Irish host family that has been carefully selected and visited by our accommodation manager and that has been vetted by Irish police.
- Three healthy meals each day:
 - o Breakfast: cereals, toast, fruit, tea/coffee/juice
 - Packed-lunch: fruit, sandwich, drink, crisps/bar
 - o Dinner: pasta/rice/potatoes with meat and vegetables/salad with dessert
 - Vegetarian families are available. Special dietary needs (coeliac etc) can be catered for on request (additional costs apply)
 - homes located between 10-30 minutes of the school in safe, residential areas.
- a wide range of families which are matched to students' needs
- for students aged 13-17 years (at the time of the course start), only one student of any mothertongue in each house unless you request otherwise.
- for students aged 12 years or younger (at the time of the course start), we may require students
 of this age to share their host-family with another student of the same nationality/mothertongue this helps avoid problems of home-sickness, shyness and anxiety in younger students
 and encourages them to spend more time at home where they could interact more with the host
 family.
- Laundry once a week
- Family details (including address, telephone numbers, names, ages and interests of the families) to be provided 3 weeks before arrival
- Students travel to and from their host families each day on public transport and it is very safe, normal and easy to do so. Host families show students the best and safest way to travel on the first day and how they should get home.
- Tip: If your child has never used public transport before, we suggest you give him/her a little experience of it in your own country before coming to Ireland it will help with any worry that you or your child may feel.





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Arrival and Departure

Airport transfers are included in our accommodation package for individual students. Here's what we offer:

- \circ $\ \ \,$ to meet the student personally in the Arrivals hall of Dublin airport
- $\circ \quad$ to sign for student on arrival if travelling as an Unaccompanied Minor
- \circ $\ \ \,$ to bring the student by private car to their host family and introduce them
- to provide a welcome pack which contains school ID card, local bus & train travel pass, local maps, school and family contact numbers, notepad and pen
- $\circ \quad$ on departure to collect the student by private car from host family
- \circ $\,$ to bring the student to the airline check-in desk and the security gates for departure
- to sign for the student at the airport check-in if an insurance waiver is required by airline or if travelling as an Unaccompanied Minor (*extra fee applies in both cases as driver must wait at airport until flight departs or until air stewards take charge – see booking form for current charges*)
- Students can generally arrive 1 or 2 days before the start of the course. Accommodation is provided on a weekly basis so students will generally leave on the same day of the week they arrive (additional nights are possible for an extra fee)

PLEASE NOTE: Students who are traveling alone should carry a letter signed by their parent(s) and with their parents' contact details giving them permission to travel and attend DLTC Language School. This may be requested at Immigration Control in the airport. The letter should provide contact details of parent(s)/guardian(s) and contact details of school (provided to you in advance of arrival).

(**Groups (10 students or more)** are met on arrival at Dublin airport in the arrivals hall and are taken by private bus to a meeting point where the students are introduced to their host families. Similarly on departure families bring their student(s) to a meeting point for departure by private bus to Dublin airport.)

Activity Programme - High Quality, Adventurous and Fun-Filled

Students attending our summer junior English course can choose to take part in our leisure activity programmes.



- Activity programme is available every week of the course. The activities include a balance of sports, entertainment, adventure and cultural visits. Each week it includes:
 - 5 afternoon activities;
 - o 2 or 3 evenings
 - 1 full-day excursion.

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- With full-day excursions to famous tourist locations around Ireland such as Galway/Athlone; Kilkenny; Wexford; Wicklow Mountains National Park; outdoor adventure activities such as climbing, kayaking/sailing, archery, zip-lines, cycling
- Fun activities like Escape Room, Adventure Quest, bowling, lazertag, karaoke, and crazy golf
- Sports such as traditional Gaelic Football, soccer, tag rugby, basketball, badminton as well as games, dance and cooking with opportunity to interact with Irish teenagers
- Half-day visits to famous tourist locations within Dublin such as Dublinia Viking Experience, Dublin Castle and City Hall, St Patricks Cathedral, National Museums
- Groups of 15 or more can request specific or additional activity programmes

The DLTC is an English language school based in Dublin, Ireland, and has been providing English language courses to foreign students since 2002. We specialise in providing courses with cultural, sporting, sightseeing and activity programmes to foreign teenagers and adolescents – coming to our courses either as individuals or as groups.

For that reason we spend as much class time as possible getting students to talk and getting students to talk about topics that are relevant and interesting to them. We believe that if a topic is not interesting or relevant, students won't want to talk; and if they don't want to talk, then they'll never learn to speak the language.

During the summer, the DLTC English Language School offers our Summer Junior English & Activity programmes. This is a hugely popular programme and we have been operating it since 2003. On this programme, we welcome private individual students - who travel on their own or with friends - as well as larger groups of teenagers from language schools, secondary schools, and other youth organisations in any country.

During the spring and autumn, DLTC English Language School welcomes groups from secondary schools around Europe and the World who want to spend a study week in Ireland. We provide an English language course to suit the needs of the group; accommodation and meals with an Irish host family; transfer service to and from Dublin airport; and an activity programme specifically designed according to the wishes and budget of the group so that they can enjoy the famous sights and entertainment activities that Dublin and Ireland has to offer.
